Notice to residents:

In recent months, the Village of Sheridan has received numerous complaints from residents in reference to chickens being kept in town.

This issue has been recently addressed by The Village Board and the following ordinance will remain in place:



Municipal Code of Sheridan, Chapter 21 prohibits the keeping of chickens, ducks, geese other fowl or farm type livestock within the village limits.

Violations of this code can include fines from \$150-\$750.
