Langel ordered for Boring to be removed by the Dubuque County Sheriff Department as he continued to escalate while presenting his case. Huniker advised the City will follow up with a formal written notice of the outcome of the meeting and the timeframe they have to remove the nuisance. Langel called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion by Smock, seconded by Tuel to adjourn at 6:12PM. Ayes: all, carried.
