<u>Prayer of the Day</u> O God, you gave your only Son to suffer death on the cross for our redemption, and by his glorious resurrection you delivered us from the power of death. Make us die every day to sin, that we may live with him forever in the joy of the resurrection, through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

First Lesson Ezekiel 37:1-10,14 1 The hand of the Lord came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the Lord, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it was full of bones.2 Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, there were very many in the open valley; and indeed they were very dry.3 And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord God, You know."4 Again He said to me, "Prophesy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the Lord!5 Thus says the Lord God to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. 6 I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I am the Lord." ' " 7 So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone.8 Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but there was no breath in them.9 Also He said to me, "Prophesy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord God: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live." ' "10 So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army. 14 I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the Lord, have spoken it and performed it," says the Lord.' "

Second Lesson 1 Corinthians 5:6b-8 Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?<u>7</u> Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.<u>8</u> Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.

<u>**Gospel</u>** Luke 24:1-12 <u>1</u> Now on the first day of the week, very early in the morning, they, and certain other women with them, came to the tomb bringing the spices which they had prepared.<u>2</u> But they found the stone rolled away from the tomb.<u>3</u> Then they went in and did not find the body of the Lord Jesus. <u>4</u> And it happened, as they were greatly perplexed about this, that behold, two men stood by them in shining garments.<u>5</u> Then, as they were afraid and bowed their faces to the earth, they said to them, "Why do you seek the living among the dead?<u>6</u> He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee,<u>7</u> saying, 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.' "<u>8</u> And they remembered His words.<u>9</u> Then they returned from the tomb and told all these things to the eleven and to all the rest.<u>10</u> It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the other women with them, who told these things to</u> the apostles.<u>11</u> And their words seemed to them like idle tales, and they did not believe them.<u>12</u> But Peter arose and ran to the tomb; and stooping down, he saw the linen cloths lying by themselves; and he departed, marveling to himself at what had happened.


