Greetings again Comrades. Sorry for not having an article last month. I took my stuff with me so that I could write one but once I got there, it seemed I just couldn't find the time.

While I was on my Vacation, we lost two of our Post Members and dear friends of mine, and on the same day. Dale "Bear" Phillips and John Ball. Since Bear first transferred to our post several years ago, as President of the Legion Riders, we became close because he always had high interest in the affairs of the Post. Seems like lately, every time he was at the Post, I would run into him sitting outside when I arrived. The first thing he would ask was how the Post was doing. Recently I mentioned to him I was getting burned out and needed a replacement. He told me to hang in there because as soon as he retired or didn't have to go out of town, he wanted to be Post Commander and wanted me as his Finance Officer. I told him if he became Commander, I would come back and be Finance Officer. John Ball, on the other hand, was the one that got me the F.O. position. John was a WWII Veteran, a C.P.A., and an Honorary Life Member of our Post. At one time he was Post Finance Officer, sometime in the 90's and he used to be our Bookkeeper also. He and his wife Jo, who was also very much involved with the Auxiliary, had a Tax Business and did all of our bookkeeping at no charge. When F.O. Joan Moulton passed in early 2006, John took over as F.O. for the rest of the term as he was still doing our bookkeeping, although he had closed his business when his wife got sick. It was then that I became F.O. and he showed me how it was done. He continued as our bookkeeper for another 4 years until his health started to go bad. 






VETERANS DAY PRESENTATION


AL RIDERS DOING A GOOD DEED!


