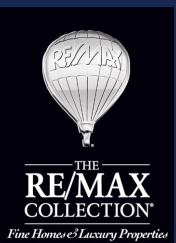

# MINUTES OF HBPOA MEETING, COAST GUARD BUILDING March 7, 2019 @ 7:00 PM

Kathy Frase, President, called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM and invited all present to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance. She welcomed all present, including three new members: Suzie Oyler and Bill and Patty Roberts.

Our president then called for a motion to accept the February Minutes as published in the Beachcomber. Cal Holland so moved, motion was seconded by Sarge Dendy and passed.

In the absence of Bud Frase, Treasurer, Kathy gave the Treasurer's Report as follows:

Balance on Hand as of 2/01/19 was \$23,809.61 and as of 2/28/19 was \$23,626.78. The report will be filed for audit.

## OLD BUSINESS:

Renewal HBPOA membership for 2019..... Kathy reminded us that the deadline to renew ones membership was 2/28/19 although certainly no one will be turned away. She also pointed out that as of tonight's meeting our count was 162 members and, apparently tonight 16 more have been added. We have exceeded the count of 168 at the end of last year already and the year is still young!

PayPal.....In an effort to make joining our association even easier, we are having PayPal set up so that dues can be paid online. This should be very helpful to those who perhaps travel a lot or who are snowbirds and hopefully will help our numbers to grow even more.

Note: At this point in the Agenda, our speaker for the evening arrived and the business part of the meeting was interrupted so that we could turn our attention to the speaker.

Kathy introduced Sheriff Al Nienhuis who was present along with several of his deputies. He began his comments by reminding us that he reports to us, the citizens and to no one else. He also wanted to be sure that we were aware of their program called, "The Careline," which was set up for people who live alone to call in daily or be called to be sure that he/she is okay. Not only has this program proven invaluable for keeping tabs on such individuals but sometimes this program provides the only human contact that some of these folks might have on any given day.

The Sheriff made some preliminary remarks about the "Neighbors by Ring" program which his office has fairly recently joined. In very simple terms, it is an electronic neighborhood watch involving a free App that facilitates communication with ones neighbors as well as law enforcement. He explained that his remarks were a prelude to a presentation by Detective Shawn Galarza whom he introduced as a "hero" in the department and gave several examples to back up this accolade. Before Sheriff Al took his leave, he opened the floor to any questions/concerns from the audience and addressed many concerns of individuals. One very interesting bit of information was that as of March 1<sup>st</sup>, Hernando Coun-

ty has two fulltime marine deputies.

Detective Galarza introduced himself as the Homeland Security and Intelligence Officer for the Hernando County and gave some details about his background. In an effort to find a program that could save the department money and at the same time be beneficial to the community, he attended a national conference where a presentation was made to promote the App, Neighbors by Ring. He was so convinced by what he saw that he brought the idea to the Hernando County Sheriff's Department and they are now partnering with Ring and with the community to better engage with the neighborhood to create a vast neighborhood watch.

Ring started with doorbells but now has entire home security systems, spotlights with cameras, LED cameras and smoke alarms and are constantly evolving to come up with new innovations for home security. Their mission is to reduce crime in neighborhoods and their motto is "Always Home." Most recently with the Neighbors by Ring, crime is being reduced by 50% in neighborhoods. By texting hernadocounty to 555888, you can download the free Neighbors App and utilize it to see what's happening in your community right now. This App can also be used with many other home security systems. You can be alerted to situations, can share videos or other information that might be vital in preventing a potential home invasion or perhaps a safety issue not involving crime. Detective Galarza

showed many examples in his presentation of situations where this vast neighborhood watch has prevented a crime from occurring. It is also helpful to know that anonymity is always maintained. Another very efficient aspect of the Neighbors App is the ability for individual portals for law enforcement in any given community, allowing the officer responsible for policing a specific community to access a zone specifically for that community instead of having to scroll through feeds from other communities.

By doing these presentations, Detective Galarza is able to give out Ring cameras and the department is also able to donate cameras to people who have been victimized multiple times and victims of domestic violence and will even install cameras for those who are not able to do it themselves. All of this is an effort to interact with communities and promote community policing. At the end of Detective Galarza's very informative presentation, two Ring cameras were raffled off and were won by our new member, Bill Roberts and by Jesse Manno!

One huge possible impact if this project were to go through could be flooding of homes on Flamingo Blvd. during storm surges or even just high tides. ## BOATING SAFETY ID CARD REQUIREMENT

For anyone born on or after January 1, 1988, who will be operating a boat in Florida waters with an engine of ten (10) horsepower or more, the law requires them to complete an [approved boating safety course](#) and obtain a Florida Boating Safety ID Card. This card is not a boating license, it is a certification that the person named on the card has successfully completed the required boating safety course. The card does not expire. You can find information on how to obtain the card below.

### How to get a Florida Boating Safety ID Card

After you have successfully completed an approved Florida [boating safety course](#), please follow these steps:

Check with your course provider or instructor to see if they will automatically send a request to FWC to issue a card. Many online course providers, and some classroom providers, automatically submit a ID card request to FWC for all of their

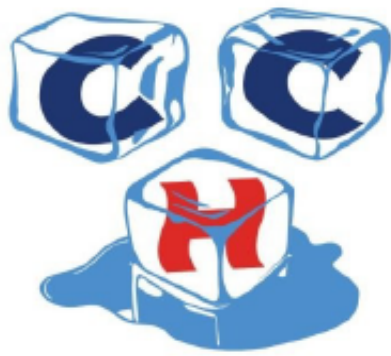

students who successfully complete an approved Florida course. (Because the course providers are not affiliated with FWC, they must send student information to FWC in order for a card to be issued.) If your course provider automatically sends a request to FWC for your card, you should receive that card within 2 to 3 weeks.

If the course provider or instructor is not going to submit the information for FWC to issue a card, you can do so using the course completion certificate you receive from the provider after you have passed the course. For online courses, make sure you can print a copy of this certificate from their website or that you can get an electronic copy. If you take a classroom course, make sure your instructor provides proof of completion. This proof can be a card or certificate, but in order for FWC to issue a boating safety ID card, the proof of completion must have the following information:

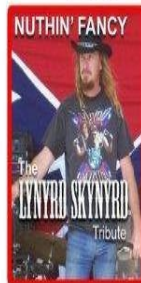

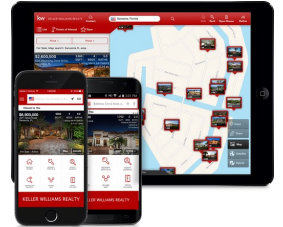
