The certification of accounts for the 2018 audit was to Newfield National Bank.

Cynthia from MES e-mailed the Board in reference to 2 invoices they were waiting payment for. We verified that their invoice (1332919 & 1337889) in the amount of \$363.50 was paid at the last meeting (PO's 5720 & 5733) with check number 12056. These payments had not yet cleared the bank. We verified that the payments are being sent to the correct address. Check number 12056 will have a stop payment order submitted. A new check (#12113) was issued in the amount of #363.50 and will be sent to satisfy the account. Mykola Myronowskyj will follow up with MES to ensure that the payment was received and credited.

Joe Scapellato reported that Nat Alexander submitted a duplicate invoice. Joe contacted Nat Alexander and rectified the error.

The Board is low on PO's, Mykola Myronowskyj will reach out to Paladino Printers and place an order.

A motion to pay all bills and to accept the Treasurers report was made by Mykola Myronowskyj and was seconded by Andrew Bellone Jr.

6. New Business

The annual renewal of the Atlantic Switch and Generator maintenance contract was received. The pricing and terms remain the same as last year. The Board agreed, and the Chairman signed the renewal contract.

Kelly from Borelli / Glenn Insurance provided us a copy of the insurance certificate for the rescue truck. She also sent a copy to VFIS.

Kelly from Borelli / Glenn Insurance notified the Board via e-mail that the 2018 audit of the workman's comp insurance was in dispute. There are 2 other fire companies that share our policy and one of them raised concerns. The audit revealed that the Board was set to receive a refund in the amount of \$\\$. which was intended to be used as a credit to the billing, however until the dispute is resolved, full payment of the installment will be required. Kelly stated that as soon as the dispute is resolved, she will notify us.

OHD, the company that recertifies our fit testing machine requested information on our tax exemption status. Mykola Myronowskyj will send them a copy of the ST-5 tax exemption form.

Ed Paul of Ball Buckley & Seher was present to go over the 2018 Audit with the Board. The annual audit did not reveal any issues, and the Board accepted the Audit as written.
