# LORD MAKE ME OVER

**Psalm 51:10** "Create in me a clean heart, and renew a right spirit within me." (KJV)

**Create Definition:** bring (something) into existence. Hebrew word "bara" – to shape, form, fashion.

Ephesians 2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

**Situation:** This is a Psalm of King David a cry unto God, after multiple acts of sin that resulted in the death of 1 man, and the king getting a new queen. David committed adultery with one of the soldiers wife in his Army and got her pregnant. He then tried to cover up this sin by bringing the soldier home to sleep with his wife with the hopes of hiding his sin. But the soldier refused to take pleasure when so many other soldiers were risking their lives in the war. So David sinned further by writing out a death sentence for Uriah the husband of Bathsheba, asking Uriah to carry the note to the Captain of the Army. Once David's orders were complete and Uriah was dead, he married Bathsheba thinking he avoided his secret getting out. 2 Samuel 11:1-27

But God directed the prophet Nathan to go to the King and show him, what he did was not pleasing or right. 2 Samuel 12:1 – 12

David humbles himself and repents 2 Samuel 12:13 – 17.
