FOR THE WEEK OF September 24, 2017

MONDAY – Psalm 119:49-56 (Zayin)

This section speaks of God’s Word being our comfort. How have you been comforted by knowing the Word of God?

It also speaks of theme songs. What song would describe your faith at this point of your life? Why?

TUESDAY – Psalm 119:57-64 (Heth)

What would “seeking God’s face with all one’s heart” look like, in your opinion?

WEDNESDAY – Psalm 119:65-72 (Teth)

What do you think this “affliction” might have been that the Psalmist talks about in verses 67 and 71? How does God use trials and troubling times to get us to understand His Word better?

THURSDAY – Psalm 119:73-80 (Yodh)

What seems to be the Psalmist’s attitude in the face of opposition? According to verse 73, what role does God have in our understanding of His Word? How does God now help those of us living in the New Testament times?

FRIDAY – Psalm 119:81-88 (Kaph)

What words or phrases does the Psalmist use to describe how he feels in the face of opposition? How does the Word of God help strengthen YOU during times of trial and opposition?

SATURDAY – Psalm 119:89-96 (Lamedh)

What makes the Psalmist so sure of the enduring Word of God? What things does he look to to remind him of God’s faithfulness?
