Following the review of our meeting minutes from the December 12 meeting and current treasurer's report, we moved on to business. The officers and board welcomed reelected director, Nanette Till and newly elected director, Renee Pipinich, both who will serve through December 31, 2021. Vice-President George Pfeiffer received a verbal resignation from President Gordon Hinders. George Pfeiffer will serve as Acting CSRHA President through Gordon Hinders' term ending December 31, 2019. This results in a vacant position in the CSRHA leadership; this will be tabled for the next board meeting.

The Montana Reining Horse Association has accepted the CSRHA to co-affiliate with them at the *Slide Into Summer* show in **Livingston, Montana** on **June 20-23, 2019**. This show will serve as the NRHA requirement of each affiliate hosting a minimum of three NRHA sanctioned events per year. CSRHA points will not be tabulated for club shows and/or year-end awards at this event. The CSRHA is under no obligation to assist with this event, but volunteers will be greatly appreciated by the MRHA.

Kathy Nicholson reported that she would like write-ups and photos from the CSRHA year-end champions and reserve champions by **January 31, 2019** so she can move ahead with the CSRHA Membership Directory. Kathy would like advertisers and sponsors to submit their information to her by **March 1, 2019**. She would like to have them available for distribution by the Awards Banquet in April.

Stephanie Williams reported on the progress the Awards Committee has made with regards to both year-end awards and 2019 class prizes. There have been a number of great suggestions submitted this year, so be sure to plan to show with the CSRHA this summer. Prizes will range from jackets and vests to tack, including the year-end trophy saddle!

The CSRHA submitted a poll for the clinic, banquet, and Fun Day in April and received a relatively even split between the two weekends that were being considered. After additional discussion, it was voted to host a *clinic* on **April 25-26**, the CSRHA *year-end banquet* on the evening of **April 26**, with the CSRHA *Fun Day* on **April 27**. The clinic will be scheduled depending on the level of interest. Nanette Till and Stephanie Williams will be working with The Irma Hotel in **Cody, Wyoming** for room rates and planning the banquet which will include their famous (and delicious) buffet.

The *Grasslands Market Slide* will be at the Wyoming State Fairgrounds in **Douglas, Wyoming** on **May 11-12, 2019**. Board of Director Debbie Russell and her husband, Bill are working with the fairgrounds' staff to ensure good ground conditions in the Ford Pavillion along with having access to the indoor stalls and Pepsi arena. Renee Pipinich expressed her concern for the ground and may meet with Building and Grounds Supervisor, Mark Maue to discuss.

George Pfeiffer brought up some new business to the CSRHA which included the possibility of hosting a MRHA/YRHA/CSRHA circuit award with the idea that each affiliate could designate a show to be their own affiliate event. The MRHA's would be the Slide Into Summer show in Livingston, MT; the YRHA's affiliate show would be one of the Yellowstone Slide shows at Anderson Training Stables in Wilsall, MT; and the CSRHA's affiliate show would be the Grasslands Market Slide in Douglas, WY. Each affiliate would donate money and give an award for the high-point in each of the combined shows. The idea would be to get each association out of their comfort zones and participate/support each affiliate's shows. This concept will be discussed further if there is interest. This may become a reality for the CSRHA in 2020 and beyond.
