



Crisis Intervention Program



The ***Crisis Intervention*** Behavior Management Team provides short-term intensive assessment and intervention services for families that are in a crisis situation. These families require in-home training in order to provide them with strategies in managing the severe behaviors often associated with Autism.

Crisis Intervention services will be provided by trained professionals in the fields of psychology, behavior analysis, social work and special education. Through interviews with the family, a service needs assessment will be developed. Parents will receive eight weeks of training with a crisis team manager. These sessions will also be followed up on a weekly basis.

This is a free service for families in need who have ***OPWDD simple eligibility*** for their child.
