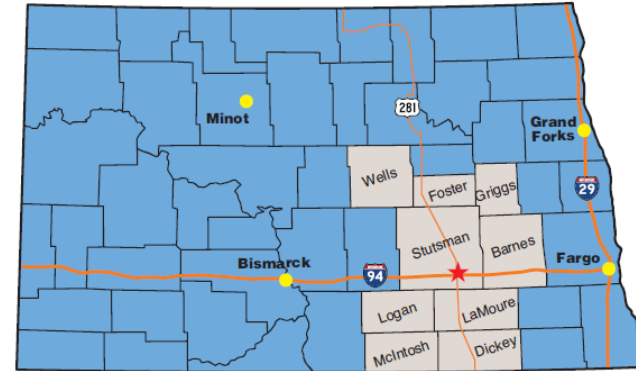

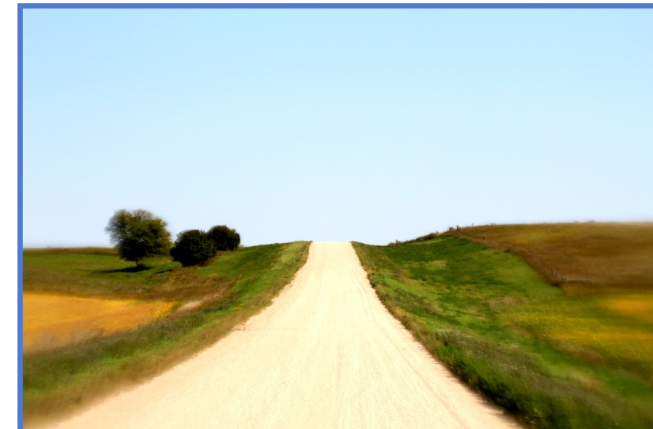

Infrastructure

Community Development Block Grant

The CDBG Program provides financial assistance to eligible units of local Governments in the form of grants and loans for Public Facilities, Housing Rehabilitation and Economic Development projects. The primary beneficiaries of these projects must be very low and low income individuals.

Examples of projects:

- Public Facilities - water and sewer projects, removal of architectural barriers, fire halls, ambulances, etc.
- Economic Development - loans to businesses that create jobs for low income persons.
- Housing - housing rehabilitation of very low and low income homeowner units and rental units.

USDA Community Facilities Program

The USDA Community Facilities program provides financial assistance to eligible units of local Governments in the form of low interest loans for Public Facilities projects.

Child Care Initiative

The Child Care Initiative of the SCDRC has established as a matter of policy: wage earners must be confident their children are responsibly tended to by qualified and licensed personnel.

SCDRC's offering of gap financing is to encourage traditional lenders to extend loans that create, strengthen, and/or assist businesses in the region, spurring economic growth and jobs.

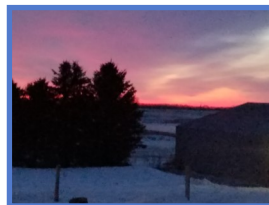
Revolving loan funds provided by SCDRC include:

- Economic Development Administration (EDA) Revolving Loan Fund
- Two United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Intermediary Relending Program funds
- The North Dakota Community Development Loan Fund (CDLF).

All programs require a matching private lender, equity of at least 10% of total project cost, first or second position on collateral and personal guaranty of principals.

A \$250 application fee is payable with the initial application.
