CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING

BY-LAW NUMBER 2016-006 (as amended by By-laws 2016-027, 2016-038 and 2018-002)

Being a By-law to set Fees for Municipal Services.

Recitals:

- 1. The *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, authorizes Ontario's municipalities to establish user fees for various municipal services.
- 2. Several different by-laws currently establish fees and charges for municipal services. Council considers it expedient to contain all user fees within a single by-law, with the exceptions of the fees for: Building Permits; the fees associated with the Crooks Cemetery; and the fees for use of Blake Hall.
- 3. Blake Hall Rental/Use Fees are contained in By-law 878-2011, as amended or replaced from time to time.
- 4. Building Permit fees are contained in By-law 810-2009, as amended or replaced from time to time.
- 5. Crooks Cemetery fees are contained in By-law 951-2012, as amended or replaced from time to time.

ACCORDINGLY, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>Short Title</u>: This By-law is referred to as the "User Fee By-law".
- 2. <u>Administration Fees</u>: The Schedule to this By-law establishes fees for various services offered by the Corporation.
- 3. <u>Exemption</u>: Residents of Neebing age 65 and over are exempt from payment for photocopying or scanning documents set out in the Schedule to this By-law.
- 4. <u>Interest</u>: Any fees payable under this By-law, or any other by-law of the Municipality of Neebing that sets out fees for permits, purchases, licences or other matters, that are not paid at the time they are due, are subject to interest at one and one-quarter (1.25%) per cent per month, compounded.
- 5. Addition to Tax Rolls: Where applicable, the Municipality of Neebing may add uncollected fees payable under this By-law, or any other by-law of the Municipality of Neebing that sets out fees for permits, purchases, licences or other matters, to the tax roll for property owned by the person who owes the fees, and collect them in like manner as municipal taxes are collected. As at the time they are added to the tax roll, the interest rate specified in Section 4 shall cease to apply, and interest and penalties applicable to unpaid taxes shall apply instead.

6. <u>Amendment to By-law 2014-006 (Marriage)</u>: Section 4 of By-law 2014-006 is repealed and the following is substituted in its place:

<u>"Fees for Service</u>: Fees payable to the Municipality of Neebing for marriage solemnization services are set out in By-law 2016-006. Fees must be paid a minimum of three (3) business days prior to the service. If the fee is not paid, the service is subject to cancellation."

- 7. <u>First Amendment to By-law 2015-017 (Landfill Site)</u>: Schedule "A" to By-law 2015-017 is repealed.
- 8. <u>Second Amendment to By-law 2015-017 (Landfill Site)</u>: The phrases

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"in Schedule "A" to this By-law"; and 
"in Schedule "A" for disposal of Waste"; 
"in Schedule "A"; and 
"appended to this By-law as Schedule "A"
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are each replaced with the phrase "in By-law 2016-006" wherever each occurs throughout the by-law, being:

- a) the opening sentence of Section 7;
- b) the first and last paragraphs of Section 7.1;
- c) Section 7.2; and
- d) Section 7.5; and
- e) the third paragraph of Section 8; and
- f) Section 10.
- 9. <u>First Amendment to By-law 2014-029 (Kennels)</u>: Section 2.05 of By-law 2014-029, which reads as follows:

<u>"Licence Fees & Term</u>: Licences are valid for the calendar year and must be renewed annually. The fee for a Licence is twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. Where a new Licence (and not a renewal of an existing Licence) is issued after October 1 in any year, the Licence fee payable is thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars and the Licence shall be valid until December 31 of the following year."

is amended by

- a) deleting the phrase "twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars" and replacing it with the phrase "set out in By-law 2016-006"; and
- b) by deleting the phrase "thirty-five (\$35.00) dollars" and replacing it with the phrase "set out in By-law 2016-006".
- 10. <u>Second Amendment to By-law 2014-029 (Kennels)</u>: Section 3.05 of By-law 2014-029, which reads as follows:

<u>"Re-Inspection Fee</u>: When a re-inspection is required to confirm compliance with a condition or an order imposed or because the Applicant or Operator failed to appear at a scheduled inspection, a re-inspection fee of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars may be imposed."

is amended by deleting the phrase "of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars may be imposed" and replacing it with the phrase "as set out in By-law 2016-006 will be imposed".

11. <u>Amendment to By-law 561-2002 (Fire)</u>: By-law 561-2002, being a by-law to establish a volunteer emergency services department, is amended by deleting Appendix "B" and replacing it with the following:

Appendix "B" to
By-law 561-2002
Compensation for the Fire Department

By-law 2016-006, being the Municipality of Neebing User Fee By-law, provides for fees for service and/or or cost-recoveries on behalf of the Neebing Emergency Services. It also provides for the fees for the issuance of fire permits.

The Fire Chief shall apply for compensation offered through the Ministry of Transportation for Ontario (or such other agency that assumes the role currently undertaken by the Ministry) for attendance at all motor vehicle accidents that occur on Provincial Highways. Compensatory rates, procedures, forms and applications are all established by the Province for this compensation.

12. <u>Amendment to By-law 562-2002 (Fire Permits)</u>: Section 7 of By-law 562-2002, which reads as follows:

"The cost of such permit to be not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$15.00 except for yearly cooking and incinerator permits where there will be no charge for said permits."

is repealed, and the following is substituted:

"Fees for permits, where applicable, are set out in By-law 2016-006."

13. <u>Amendment to By-law 697-2005 (Trailer Siting)</u>: Section 4 of By-law 697-2005, which reads as follows:

"The fee for such licence shall be the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for every month or portion of a month that the trailer or recreation vehicle is located in the Municipality."

Is amended by substituting "as set out in By-law 2016-006" for the phrase "the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00)".

- 14. Repeals: The following by-laws are repealed in their entirety:
 - a) 117-84 (trailer licences);
 - b) 304-1994 (building permit fees older);
 - c) 759-2008 (Hall fees, planning fees);
 - d) 911-2011 (Landfill site fees older);
 - e) 944-2012 (haul permit fees).
- 15. <u>Effective Date</u>: This By-law shall take effect on the date that it is passed.
