

COVID Protocols Jr DECATS 2022

- Fevers over 100 need to be evaluated by a physician before returning to Jr DECATS.
- For positive students-
- 5 days at home
- May return day 6 and wear KN95 (available on Amazon) mask x 5 more days.
- If positive family member-
- best to test other family members on day 3
- may attend DECATS if asymptomatic. Must wear KN95 mask x 10 days.
- May remove for outdoor activities.
- If eating indoors, must sit at least 6 feet away from others while unmasked.

HOW YOU CAN HELP!


- Pack a "no throw" or "low throw" lunch.


JR. DECATS IMPORTANT INFORMATION


JR. DECATS CARPOOL HIGHLIGHTS

JR. DECATS CARPOOL HIGHLIGHTS

- Single line
- Must follow designated traffic pattern –
- Morning drop off
 - from eastbound Harvest Hill turn right in to the entrance
 - continue over the bridge to the bell tower
 - watch for DECATS greeters
- Afternoon pick up
 - from eastbound Harvest Hill turn right in to the entrance (again)
 - follow traffic pattern through Harvest Hill lot
 - continue over the bridge to the bell tower
