Edward Tick is co-founder of Soldier's Heart, will speak about his new book, *Warrior's Return: Restoring the Soul After War*.

Soldier's Heart, founded in 2006, tends the invisible wounds of PTSD, resulting from war and military service. Soldier's Heart believes that these "soul wounds" are sacred and, properly tended, can lead to wisdom and transformation. Preschoolers can listen to a story and parents learn more about library services for families.

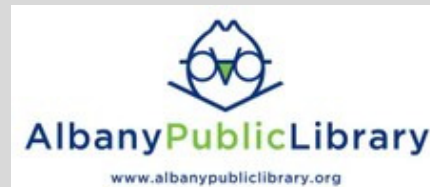
- **12:30-2:30 - Meet the Information Providers**
