SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES: The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setter Dogs and Bitches who on the day of the show will be over 6 months of age and under 18 months of age. All dogs entered in the Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in the Regular Classes at this show. Indicate "Puppy Sweepstakes" in the space for Additional Classes (include age division). **Puppy Sweepstakes** will be as follows in both sexes: 6 months and under 9 months; 9 months and under 12 months; 12 months and under 15 months; 15 months and under 18 months.

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES: The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Irish Setter Dogs and Bitches who on the day of the show will be at least 7 years of age. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered in Veteran Sweepstakes. Winners of the Veteran Sweepstakes Classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite in Sex to Best in Veteran Sweepstakes. Veteran Sweepstakes entrants do **NOT** need to be entered in another class at the show. Entries shall be made on the same entry form as for Regular Classes. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and the appropriate age and sex in the space designated "Additional Classes." **Veteran Sweepstakes Classes** will be as follows in both sexes: 7 years and under 9 years; 9 years and under 11 years; 11 years and older.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!

These shows will be governed by the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the AKC, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Premium List.

1. THE MANAGEMENT WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOSS OF OR DAMAGE TO ANY DOG EXHIBITED, OR FOR THE POSSESSIONS OF ANY EXHIBITOR, WHETHER THE RESULT OF ACCIDENT OR ANY OTHER CAUSE. IT IS DISTINCTLY UNDERSTOOD THAT EVERY DOG AT THESE SHOWS IS IN THE CARE, CUSTODY AND CONTROL OF HIS OWNER OR HANDLER DURING THE ENTIRE TIME THE DOG IS ON THE SHOW PREMISES.

2. The club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the club or any official thereof.

3. No space will be provided for dogs that are not entered.

4. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the ring before the completion of the judging of the breed and the superintendent advised at once in the event of any discrepancy.

5. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children at these shows.

6. No grooming tables, exercise pens, or canopies will be allowed in the aisles, and all grooming must be done in areas specified by the club.

7. Due to the increased number of crates and grooming tables, chairs will not be allowed in the handlers' section.

8. Private exercise pens will NOT be allowed.

9. No Camper Hookups.

10. DO NOT LEAVE DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.

11. NO SMOKING UNDER THE TENTS.

12. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE CONSUMED ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS)

(Remember to check the box near the bottom of the entry form)

AKC National Owner-Handler Series is a non-titling competition created in direct response to Owner-Handlers' desire to compete against other Owner-Handlers. Owner-Handlers will still enter and compete in the regular classes to win Best of Breed. Then, just before the regular class judging is complete, the recognition of Owner-Handler Best of Breed will be awarded.

Determining Exhibitor Eligibility: The first step in judging the AKC National Owner-Handled Series is determining exhibitor eligibility. Follow these tips to properly make the eligibility determination: **Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.**

* The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.

* Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.

* Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

* Dogs must be handled by an owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series throughout the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition and subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.

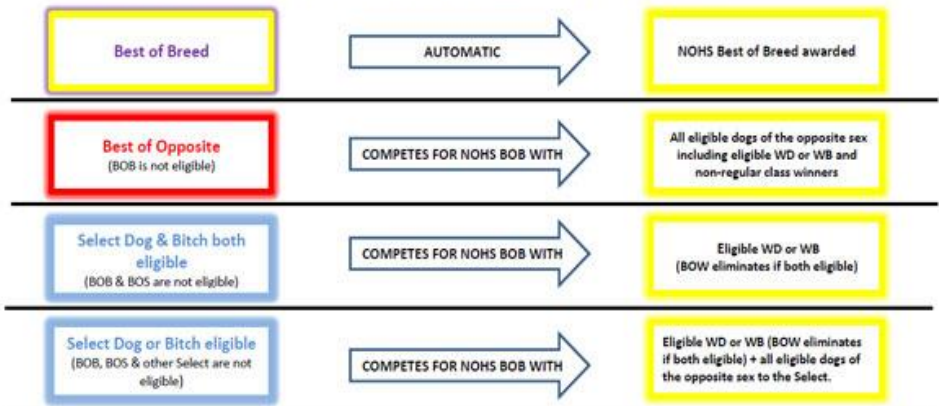
* The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.

Designating NOHS Best of Breed



Once the judge has awarded BOB/BOV, BOW, BOS and Selects

- Steward should compare the eligible entries against the awards
- Advise the judge of the awarded dogs indicated as eligible to compete (*) in the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS)
- Determine by the flow chart which entries remain in the ring for the designation of NOHS Best of Breed



If none of the above awards (BOB, BOS, Select Dog, or Select Bitch) are indicated as eligible, judge is to award NOHS Best of Breed from any eligible dog competing for Best of Breed, including WD and WB. BOW will eliminate the Winners of the opposite sex automatically.

Dogs must be entered in the NOHS Competition to be eligible for NOHS Best of Breed. (Indicated by an "****") Only those dogs indicated by an asterisk (*) and eligible to compete for NOHS BOB (entered in BOB, move-ups, 1st place non-regular, WD & WB) are eligible for the NOHS award. Eligible Select DOES NOT automatically eliminate eligible same sex Winners.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event of the show for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
