### Potted Plant Show

1. Exhibitors must reside within the Southwest District.
1. All entries must have been in exhibitor's possession at least 3 months.
2. The containers in which the plant is grown in will not be judged.
3. Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded. Places will be awarded as follows:

4. All classes will have Junior and Senior divisions. Each plant will be marked to distinguish Junior and Senior entries.
5. If plants are too large to be moved easily by show committee, they will not be accepted.
6. All hanging baskets must be equipped with rings and hooks for hanging. Total length not to exceed 5 feet.
