Dear Friends in Christ,

Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity. Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. As you know, the Mars Transition Team continues its work. The survey responses have been heart-felt, honest, and enlightening. The Team is still collecting comments, and we hope to present the full results to the congregation in March. Our plan is to have a single service March 17: after worship, we will present the findings (and our conclusions), then we will all go to the Social Hall for more discussion.

Some of you have expressed frustration with how slowly things are moving. You ask, "Why haven't we started to interview candidates yet?" My answer: If we cannot articulate where we hope to be in the future, how will we know when we meet the person who will take us there? We are still working on describing our current condition – we are not yet ready to describe the type of person we think we need.

The Team will prepare and present a Mission Study, and the ENTIRE CONREGATION will vote to approve it. The eventual date is somewhat of a "moving target," but we hope to elect a Pastor Nominating Committee by May-June.

One of the things that jumps out to the Team is the diversity of responses and opinions from the Mars members. There seems to be a lack of consensus, perhaps a lack of unity – the answers and comments are all over the map!

My brothers and sisters, we (you?) need to find something to unify around! Our focus should no longer be on the past (particularly 2017), but where we are NOW, and where we hope to be in the future. Of course, looking to our history is helpful, but we should not be held hostage by the past. Mars will only move forward if we engage in open and honest conversations about who we are TODAY, and (again) how we can come together as a unified Body of Christ.

First and foremost, please PRAY for the work of the Transition Team. These eight persons are devoted and committed members, and they are working very hard to lead the process. To be sure, our meetings have been lively, engaging, even argumentative. But the Team is (again) fully committed to presenting a frank assessment of:

- Who Mars UP Church is
- What is happening in our community
- The challenges we face
- Our hopes and dreams

And what type of pastor we need

What can the rest of us do? Please refer to the passage above....

Proceeds will support the Mars UP Student fellowship retreats & Summer 2019 mission trip to West Virginia, and continued student growth as a ministry.




## Walk-In Communion—March 6th (5pm to 7:30pm)

## Mars United Presbyterian Church GriefShare Sessions for Spring 2019

#### LIVING WITH GRIEF — SESSION 1

This session introduces you to GriefShare. It also explains what living with grief is like, why you shouldn't be ashamed of your grief and why you shouldn't rush through your healing.

#### THE JOURNEY OF GRIEF — SESSION 2

This session prepares you for what to expect along the journey of grief. At the same time, it emphasizes that everyone's journey is unique and warns against comparing grief experiences.

#### THE EFFECTS OF GRIEF — SESSION 3

You're probably surprised at how debilitating grief is. This session explains that this is normal and suggests practical ways to find comfort.

#### WHEN YOUR SPOUSE DIES — SESSION 4

If you've lost your spouse, this session helps you think through the critical issues involved in your healing. It also begins preparing you to face the difficult transition into a new reality without your spouse.

#### YOUR FAMILY AND GRIEF — SESSION 5

This session shares how to keep your family afloat when its members are drowning in grief. It also presents some of the unique issues involved if you're grieving the death of a child.

#### WHY? — SESSION 6

Just because God doesn't answer all of your questions doesn't mean He won't answer any of them. This session answers the "Why" questions and encourages you to begin asking other questions as well.

#### THE UNIQUENESS OF GRIEF, PT. 1 — SESSION 7

This session explores how the causes of, and your responses to, your loved one's death affect your grief. Topics addressed include suicide, long-term illness, murder and false guilt.

#### THE UNIQUENESS OF GRIEF, PT. 2 — SESSION 8

Relationships, past and present, affect your grief. This session helps you address insensitive comforters and unresolved conflict with a deceased loved one.

#### GOD'S PRESCRIPTION FOR GRIEF — SESSION 9

The bereaved are often overwhelmed by the advice they receive from others. And often, what goes unnoticed is what God says about healing. This session tells you how to position yourself to experience God's healing.

#### STUCK IN GRIEF — SESSION 10

It's easy to get stuck along the journey of grief, This session explains how to keep moving on the path to healing.

#### TOP TWENTY LESSONS OF GRIEF, PT. 1 — SESSION 11

In this session, those who've walked the journey of grief will share what they've learned and how they've grown from their grief experience.

#### TOP TWENTY LESSONS OF GRIEF, PT. 2 — SESSION 12

In this session you'll hear the most significant lessons that can be learned during grief.

#### HEAVEN — SESSION 13

This session gives practical advice on how to tap into, and hold onto, the source of hope in this disappointing world.
