During the holiday season, please remember that COVID 19 is still with us. Positivity rates are increasing and the transmission rate remains high in Queens.

Late last week, a non-direct care, asymptomatic, staff member tested positive for COVID and is on 10-day quarantine. As required, all residents and staff were tested. All results have come back negative, and no one is displaying any signs or symptoms of COVID19. No further action is required at this time.

We continue to monitor our residents daily and screen all employees and visitors upon arrival. During visitation masks are required to be worn at all times.

If you or your loved one has not yet been vaccinated or received a booster, we strongly urge you to do it now. The most recent strains of COVID are highly transmissible meaning that they are easy to pass along to someone else.

As the holidays approach, take precautions to keep our residents and yourself healthy. Wear a mask, wash, or sanitize your hands often. Maintain distance from those around you. Get vaccinated or get the booster if you are eligible. If you feel ill in any way, please do not visit.
