## Ability Van & Bus

The Preeceville Ability Bus Board has available for rent an Ability Bus and Van. The van is equipped with a wheelchair ramp, and can fit two wheelchairs, one passenger and the driver or one wheelchair and three passengers plus the driver. There is a minimum charge of \$10.00 per booking and \$0.60/km for the van. The bus has a capacity of four wheelchairs and six passengers, or three wheelchairs and eight passengers.
