We are fortunate to have great teachers and staff who educate our kids in their classrooms. HASC exists to enrich the school experience for our kids by funding “extras” on our campus. A typical meeting and event is planned by an average of 5 parents and participation in fundraisers is anything from 1-20% of our population. 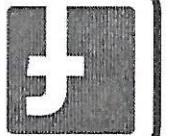
