

Ordinance No. 51

An ordinance requiring owners of motor vehicles subject to license tax in the City of Warrensburg to display number plate furnished by the City Collector on the left hand side of such motor vehicles, and making a violation of this ordinance a misdemeanor punishable by fine.

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Warrensburg, Missouri, as follows:-

Section.1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or owners of any motor vehicle, residing within the corporate limits of the City of Warrensburg, Missouri, to run, drive or operate such motor vehicle upon any street, avenue or alley or public highway, within the corporate limits of the City of Warrensburg, without displaying the number plate furnished to the owner or owners of such motor vehicle by the City Collector upon payment of the license tax on such motor vehicle; said number plate to be displayed on the left hand side of such motor vehicle in a place easily seen and the number thereon to correspond to the number of the license for such motor vehicle as shown by the records of the City Collector.

Section 2. Any one violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor
