IMPORTANT reminders!



*Golf Carts are **NOT** allowed on the beach.

*Only fire wood is to be burned in firepits, all other material is to be disposed of in the correct manner. Absolutely **NO PLASTIC** is to be burned.

***All visitors and service workers must be registered** or they will be refused entry into the park. Visitors that are not registered and are using Cedar Cove facilities will be asked to leave the park. You are not allowed unlimited visitors. Ideally visitors must be able to park at your site, with the exception for smaller sites, then overflow parking can be used. Visitors that wish to bring a boat, must pay for a dock slip for the day, and their trailer must be parked in the boat trailer storage area, at the end of the park, (see location on park map) and the vehicle can park at your site.

You can not register visitors that have no intention of visiting you at your site.

***Children under the age of 12** must be accompanied by an adult when using the pool.

***Reservations WILL NOT** be made for the Patio at the Lakeside Grill

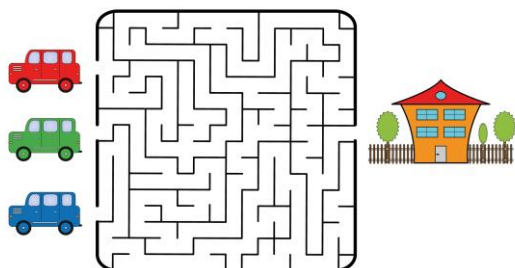
*There will be **NO** Seasonal Guest Volley ball tournament this year.

One of our Seasonal Guests, Bree who is a Paramedic, has offered to run an Information session on August 11th at 2pm, at The Pavilion (if registration is high) another session will be held on August 13th. Adults and children over the age of 12 can sign up at Reception. Group limit will be 12 people. This information session will compose of how to perform adult CPR and how to use the AED.

This is only an information session. If there is interest a full WSIB course could be held at a later date, this is a certified course.
