- Follow-up discussion about Xcel reimbursement: Irrigation damage claims for the Xcel work along Parker Road. The claims are for \$191.25 and \$198.00, for a total of \$389.25. We already paid our contractor, Centennial Sprinkler, so the reimbursement will be made directly to Andover Glen Homeowners. Q3 conducting landscaped as sub contractor for Sturgeion Electric. Will follow up with Norm and review invoices.
 - Street light down and Norm has inquired 2X about the light to be replaced and the damaged one removed
 - Spruce in Front of covenant is dead and will be diagnosed and removed. Derrick speculated it was from the electric work being conducted by Xcel
- Install solar lights for added security in the park areas, much cheaper than electrical installation; Batteries strength and life are concerns noted by Pete and other members.
 - A forty dollar 1000 lumens has been set up northeast side of courts; 4 total being held at this time; another to be placed on southwest side need gardens
- Bob Stracy finished bid for City of Aurora Beautification Grant- \$3500 estimation. Proposing 6 new trees near community garden, park benches, 4ft wide rock path between tennis ct and garden. Turned in March 15th
 - Volunteers will be needed if the grant is awarded
- Republic Waste Service 3 year contract is expiring in July.
 - Six companies are authorized to conduct business in the City of Aurora and Bob has submitted a letter to each for a bid ,
 - Republic, Waste Management, Pac-Man, Garbage Man, Lies, and Pro-Disposal,
