WORTHY CHAPLAIN



My Brother and Sister Eagles, I pray all of you are well and enjoying life. You've heard it said that change is the only constant. And, the older I get, the truer that feels. Seasons come and go, and all of life changes alongside them.

Everything is always in motion.

Sometimes change is big and drastic and happens right before our eyes, while other times it's so slow and gradual that it goes unnoticed until I look back and see how far I've come. No matter how long it takes, nothing stays the same. For better or for worse, everything is always changing. But, like most people, I like routine. I like when things fall into place. I like being anchored, kept safely tethered to something that holds me in place. So often, I think we view anchors as negatives, things that might keep us stagnant and prevent us from pushing forward into new territories. And, I know in my own life, there have been moments when I have questioned these natural tendencies and the routines and habits I hold fast to. I have wondered if I might live more freely without them. However, when I pause to look closely, more and more I have come to see that these anchors are what keep me from floating away into places where I don't want to be or that I'm just not ready for yet. Instead of stifling me, that actually provide a safe place for me to grow and explore and be. Anchors still allow their boats to move and float, to find a rhythm among the waves around them. Their purpose is simply to keep a boat from drifting so far off course that it's difficult to recover. The anchors of our life can be significant things like faith, prayer, or meditation, but they can also be small and mundane like taking care of your pet, running, or reading your favorite novels. The magical thing is that they somehow offer a place of refuge in the everchanging landscapes of our lives. We waste so much of our lives in resentment, selfishness, envy and other destructive thoughts and emotions. But notice what God wants to produce in our lives: "Love, joy, peace, long suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self control" (Galatians 5:22-23) This can only happen when we acknowledge that we need God's rule in our lives and accept our absolute inability to heal our spiritual blindness. In HIS service to you.

and Thank You Judges for your help in naming the winners.


We will be going over our by-laws and doing any changes that we have talked about. We've had two readings in September and will have the third one in October and then it can be sent to the Grand.
