GREEN SHIELD

The Green Field on the shield is a symbol of hope.

KEYS

The Keys are a symbol of St. Peter. "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." Mt. 16

CHAINS

The CHAINS are also a symbol of St. Peter. The two chains remind us of St. Peter's imprisonment in Jerusalem and Rome.

SWORD

The SWORD is a symbol of St. Paul. The symbol reminds us of Paul's teaching of the sword of the spirit as the "Word of God." It also reminds us of his martyrdom as he was decapitated with a sword.

WHITE AND BLACK

The white and black on the sword recalls that the school was founded by Dominican Sisters. The Dominican Cross is white and black. The white and black hold a twofold symbolism. 1. It represents Truth over heresy. 2. They joy and purity of Christ and the importance of humility.

8 POINTED STAR

The 8 POINTED STAR is first a symbol of our Patronage to Our Lady. One of the Titles of the Blessed Mother is Morning Star. The 8 POINTED STAR also is a symbol of the 8 Beatitudes which Christ taught as a guide for our moral life.

SCIRE-AMARE-SERVIRE

The Latin words mean "TO KNOW, TO LOVE, and TO SERVE." These words remind us that our primary purpose is to know, love, and serve God in this life so that we can enjoy eternity with Him in the next.
