

**FRAUD WARNING FROM SILVER BAY POLICE DEPARTMENT**

The Silver Bay Police Department along with the Lake County Sheriff's Office want to inform our area residents of a credit card fraud. Two credit card readers were located and removed in the Silver Bay, Beaver Bay area within the last two weeks. These credit card readers collect the users credit card information. The readers are either removed from the machines or downloaded remotely.

We suggest that everyone check their bank accounts for fraudulent activity. If there are transactions that you were unaware of and are sure you didn't make, contact your banking institution and report the fraud. The banking institution will contact either the Police Department or Sheriff's Office. We would like to remind everyone to be vigilant, and if they see anything suspicious please notify the Lake County Sheriff's Office or the Silver Bay Police Department.
