<u>Prayer of the Day</u> Almighty and eternal God, the strength of those who believe and the hope of those who doubt, may we, who have not seen, have faith in you and receive the fullness of Christ's blessing. In Jesus' Name. Amen **First Lesson** Job 19:21-29 21 "Have pity on me, have pity on me, O you my friends, For the hand of God has struck me!22 Why do you persecute me as God does, And are not satisfied with my flesh?23 "Oh, that my words were written! Oh, that they were inscribed in a book!24 That they were engraved on a rock With an iron pen and lead, forever!25 For I know that my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth;26 And after my skin is destroyed, this I know, That in my flesh I shall see God,27 Whom I shall see for myself, And my eyes shall behold, and not another. How my heart yearns within me!28 If you should say, 'How shall we persecute him?'- Since the root of the matter is found in me,29 Be afraid of the sword for yourselves; For wrath brings the punishment of the sword, That you may know there is a judgment."

<u>Second Lesson</u> Ephesians 1:15-23 <u>15</u> Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, <u>16</u> do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: <u>17</u> that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, <u>18</u> the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, <u>19</u> and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power<u>20</u> which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, <u>21</u> far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. <u>22</u> And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, <u>23</u> which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.

<u>Gospel</u> Matthew 28:11-15 <u>11</u> Now while they were going, behold, some of the guard came into the city and reported to the chief priests all the things that had happened.<u>12</u> When they had assembled with the elders and consulted together, they gave a large sum of money to the soldiers, <u>13</u> saying, "Tell them, 'His disciples came at night and stole Him away while we slept.'<u>14</u> And if this comes to the governor's ears, we will appease him and make you secure."<u>15</u> So they took the money and did as they were instructed; and this saying is commonly reported among the Jews until this day.
