



Wisdom

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) In the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth (John 16:23), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless you and your house and keep you (Num. 6:24). Glory to God the Father! (Luke 2:14) In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), **Jesus Christ**, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for you and your family, for the saints, for the leaders that God has raised up on your behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy, so that **Christ** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your house (Ezek. 13:5); for all the brethren, all those called by the name of the Lord; for the leaders of this nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the well-being of God's people; all the people of this nation, and all men, so that you and your family may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. (1 Tim. 2:1-2) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God! (Rom. 5:2)

As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we do not come to the Father based on our own worthiness or on the worthiness of you and your family, but by **Jesus Christ**, whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose. (John 1:27) As an ambassador of **Christ** (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in **Christ** and Him in us (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come before God's mercy seat, to meet with Him, to speak with Him (Ex. 25:22), having boldness to enter the holiest by the blood of **Christ** (Heb. 10:19), the precious blood that He shed (1 Pet. 1:19), for worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)! In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for you and your entire house, all of your people, on every side, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your

natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. In Christ we come into agreement with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), , and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that Christ, through us, speaks to you and your family are spirit, and they are life. (John 6:63) Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. (1 Cor. 15:57) Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We are bound to thank God always for you. (2 Thess. 1:2-3) Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore; from the rising of the sun to its going down; the Lord's name is to be praised (Ps. 113:2-6).

In Jesus' name (John 16:23) we ask the Lord God Almighty to fill you and your house with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship (Ex. 31:3). Give ear to our prayer, O God, and do not hide Yourself from our supplication. Attend to us, and hear us. (Ps. 55:1) According to the faith of God's elect (Titus 1:1) now may the God of patience and comfort (Rom. 15:5) put wisdom in your hearts, exceedingly great understanding, and largeness of heart (1 Kin. 4:29). In Christ we pray that you all may excel in wisdom (1 Kin. 4:30). Let you and your family eat the bread of wisdom and the wine of understanding (Prov. 9:5). God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) bestow on you and your people God-given wisdom (Ezra 7:25), strength, counsel and understanding (Job 12:13) and may you receive double in prudence (Job 11:6). In Christ we pray that your hearts retain God's words, and you and your house keep His commands, getting wisdom and understanding (Prov. 4:4-5), crying out for discernment, and lifting up your voices for understanding (Prov. 2:3). You, who get wisdom, love your own souls; you, who keep understanding, will find good. (Prov. 19:8) Let you and your people embrace wisdom; and may you and yours receive honor, a crown of glory (Prov.

4:8-9), a prolonged life (Duet. 6:10); and walk the path of the just (Prov. 4:18), go in the way of understanding (Prov. 9:6). Let your steps not be hindered, nor will you or your people stumble (Prov. 4:12), for your lives shall shine ever brighter unto the perfect day (Prov. 4:18), your sleep being sweet (Prov.3:24). Blessing and glory and wisdom, thanksgiving and honor and power and might, be to our God forever and ever. (Rev. 7:12)

In the name of ***Jesus Christ***, His name is Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6), God grant that you and your house dwell safely, and be secure without fear of evil (Prov. 1:33), for the Lord will be your confidence, and will keep your feet from being caught (Prov. 3:26). May you and your family find the word of God and keep it in the midst of your hearts, receiving life and health to all your flesh (Prov. 4:21-22), happiness (Prov. 3:13), riches and honor (Prov. 8:28), pleasantness and peace (Prov. 3:17), obtaining favor from the Lord (Prov. 8:35). Let God cause you to inherit wealth (Prov. 8:21), enduring riches and righteousness (Prov. 8:18), and fill your treasuries (Prov. 8:21). In ***Christ***, we pray that you and your people will keep sound wisdom and discretion, so it will be life to your souls and grace to your necks. You and your family shall walk safely in your way and you will not stumble. (Prov. 3:21-23) God grant, according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), that you and your family shall manifest the fruit of wisdom (Prov. 8:19) and traverse the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of justice (Prov. 8:20). May God, He who turns the shadow of death into morning and makes the day dark as night (Amos 5:8), be a shield to you and your house, guard your paths and preserve your way (Prov. 2:7-8). The God of our Lord ***Jesus Christ***, the Father of glory, give to you and your people the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you and your family may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward you who believe, according to the working of His mighty power. (Eph. 1:17-19) In ***Christ*** we pray that God will count you and your family worthy of this calling (2 Thess. 1:11); that you and your people may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you and your family may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy. (Col. 1:9-11) Worthy is the lamb

who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing! (Rev. 5:12) HOLINESS TO THE LORD! (Ex. 39:30) Glory to God in the Highest, our Father! (Luke 2:14)

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), whom is the covenant of the people (Is. 42:6), In *Christ* we pray that the Spirit of God is in you and your house, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you and your people (Dan. 5:14). May you and yours receive wisdom from above, wisdom that is pure, peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. (James 3:17) In *Christ* we petition the Lord God to give you and your family wisdom and counsel you night and day (Ps. 16:7), lead you and guide your every thought and every decision (Ps. 31:3), and grant you and your people wisdom and success (Eccl. 10:10) in all decisions and choices you make (Prov. 16:33), teaching you and your family to profit (Is. 48:17), instructing you and teaching you and your people in the way you should go. God, He will guide you with His eye. (Ps. 32:8) May the God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) teach you and your people to listen and increase learning and your understanding (Prov. 1:5). Let you and your family come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Tim. 2:4), receiving the Spirit of Truth from the God and Father of our Lord *Jesus Christ* (John 14:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we plead with you and your people to guard yourselves against seeing yourselves as being wise in your own eyes, but fear the Lord and depart from evil. (Prov. 3:7) The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom. (Prov. 15:33) In *Christ* we pray that you and yours will not limit wisdom to yourself, but hear the counsel of God (Job 15:8), and seek diligently (Prov. 1:28) to know wisdom and instruction, to perceive the words of understanding, to receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity; to receive prudence, knowledge and discretion, to hear and increase learning (Prov. 1:2-6); to turn any disobedience to the wisdom of the just (Luke 1:17). In Christ we petition the God and Father of all (Eph. 4:6) to give you and your family an ear to hear the rebukes of life and gain wisdom (Prov.15:31), understanding (Prov. 1:5-6), humility and honor (Prov. 15:33). Let His counsel stand in your hearts (Prov.19:21), and may you and your people not be deceived by the wisdom of this world (1 Cor. 3:18-19); but trust in the Lord with all of your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; but in all your ways acknowledge God, and allow Him to direct your path (Prov. 3:5). Your hearts may plan your way but the Lord will direct your steps.(Prov. 16:9) May the Spirit of wisdom and

understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord rest upon you and your people. (Is. 11:2) Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever! (Rev. 5:13)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), may His God and Father, the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17), teach you and your family to number your days that you and your people may gain a heart of wisdom (Ps. 90:12). In **Christ**, we pray that you and your family are wise in heart, are called prudent, and allow the sweetness of your lips to increase your learning. Let understanding be a wellspring of life to you and your house. (Prov. 16:21-24) In **Christ** we pray that Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the Lord our righteousness (Jer. 23:6), will satisfy you and your family early with His mercy, that you and your people may rejoice and be glad all your days (Ps. 90:14). As a chosen vessel of **Jesus Christ** (Acts 9:15), to bear His name, we ask in the mighty name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), that the everlasting God (Gen. 21:33) give you and your people a heart that is wise that teaches your mouth and adds learning to your lips (Prov. 16:23). In **Christ**, we pray that your lips may keep knowledge (Prov. 5:2), and that all the words of your mouths are with righteousness; nothing crooked or perverse is in them (Prov. 8:8). Let you open your mouth with wisdom, and on your tongue be the law of kindness. (Prov. 31:26) In **Christ** we ask, according to His new covenant (Heb. 8:13), the God of the holy prophets (Rev. 22:6) grant you and your family the wisdom of silence (Job 13:5), to go from the presence of a foolish man, when you do not perceive in him the lips of knowledge (Prov. 14:7), and the wisdom not to speak in the hearing of a fool, for he will despise the wisdom of your words (Prov. 23:9). Let your mouth speak wisdom, and your tongue talk of justice (Ps. 37:30) and the meditation of your heart shall bring understanding (Ps. 49:3). May your meditation be sweet to the Lord; let you and your house be glad in the Lord. (Ps. 104:34) The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom. (Prov. 10:31) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), may the words from your mouth be like deep waters; the wellspring of wisdom like a flowing brook (Prov. 18:4). Let your words be pleasant like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the bones. (Prov. 16:24) In **Christ** we petition the Lord to guide you and your family continually, and satisfy your souls in drought, and strengthen your bones; you and your people shall be like a well-

watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail. (Is. 58:11) May God's wisdom rest quietly in your hearts (Prov. 14:33); and knowledge be pleasant to your souls, discretion will preserve you and your family; understanding will keep you and your people, to deliver you and yours from the way of evil, from the man who speaks perverse things, from those who leave the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness(Prov. 2:10:13). Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing! (Rev. 5:12)

According to the riches of His glory (Eph. 3:16), may our God and Father teach you and your house in the way of wisdom and lead you in right paths (Prov. 4:11). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:51), let you and your people say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding your nearest kin, that you and your family may keep away from immorality, from the seductress who flatters with words (Prov.7:4-6). Let you and your family pay attention to wisdom; lend your ears to understanding, that you and your people may preserve discretion, and that your lips may keep knowledge. (Prov. 5:1-2) May the Lord God lead you and your family in right paths, so that when you and your people walk, your steps will not be hindered, and when you run, you will not stumble. (Prov. 4:11-12) In **Christ**, we pray that you and your people will receive God's words, and treasure His commands within you, so that you incline your ear to wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding. (Prov. 2:1-2) For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; He guards the paths of justice, and preserves the way of His saints. (Prov. 2:6-8) The fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to depart from evil is understanding. (Job 28:28) The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge. (Prov. 1:7) The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; pride and arrogance and the evil way and the perverse mouth. (Prov. 8:13) Let you and your family take firm hold of instruction, and do not let go; keep wisdom, for it is your life. (Prov. 4:13) Wisdom is a tree of life to those who take hold of her, and happy are all who retain her. (Prov. 3:18) The honeycomb which is sweet to your taste so shall the knowledge of wisdom be to your souls; and your hope will not be cut off. (Prov. 24:13-14) Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power to the Lord our God! (Rev. 19:1)

In the name of Jesus Christ, the true vine (John 15:1), let you and your people be blessed because you listen to God, watching daily at the gates of wisdom, waiting at the posts of the door of wisdom. For whoever finds wisdom finds life, and obtains favor from the Lord. (Prov. 8:34-36) Through wisdom a house is built, and by understanding it is established; by knowledge the rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches. (Prov. 24:3-4) God has taken you and your people from the ends of the earth, and called you and your family from its farthest regions, and said to you "You are My servant, I have chosen you and have not cast you away." (Is. 41:9) Our everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth (Is. 40:28) has filled you with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship (Ex. 31:3). Your family is gifted in whom the Lord has put wisdom and understanding, to know how to do all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary (Ex. 36:1), we pray in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), your Teacher and Lord (John 13:13), that you and your people shall do according to all that the Lord has commanded. (Ex. 36:1) Behold, the Lord desires truth in the inward part, and in the hidden part He will make you and your people to know wisdom. He will purge you with hyssop, and you and your family shall be clean. (Ps. 51:6-7) God Almighty, the faithful One (Deut. 7:9), will wash you and your people, and you shall be whiter than snow (Ps. 51:7). He will make you and your house to hear joy and gladness. He will hide His face from your sins, and blot out all your iniquities. (Ps. 51:8-9) May Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the LORD your righteousness (Jer. 23:6), create in you and your people a clean heart, and renew a steadfast spirit within you and yours. (Ps. 51:10) In Christ we pray that the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10) will not cast you and your family away from His presence, and He will not take His Holy Spirit from you. Instead, restore to you and your people the joy of His salvation, and uphold you and your house with His generous Spirit. Then you and your family will teach transgressors His ways, and sinners shall be converted to Him. Let the God of your salvation, deliver you and your house from blood guiltiness and your tongues shall sing aloud of His righteousness. O may the Lord open your lips, and let your mouths show forth His praise. (Ps. 51:11-15) Let you and your family give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to the God of gods! For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to the Lord of lords! To Him who alone does great wonders. To Him who by wisdom made the heavens, for His mercy endures

forever. To Him who laid out the earth above the waters. For His mercy endures forever. To Him who made great lights. For His mercy endures forever. (Ps. 136:5-7) Who remembered you and your house in your lowly state? For His mercy endures forever. He rescued you and your family from your enemies. For His mercy endures forever. Who gives food to all flesh? For His mercy endures forever. Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven! For His mercy endures forever. (Ps. 136:23-26) Let you and your people fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and let you worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water. (Rev. 14:7)

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), ***Jesus Christ***, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in ***Christ***, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that ***Christ*** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord ***Jesus Christ***. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and ***Christ*** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of

sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

Concerning the things we pray for you and your house, we come into agreement with you (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1), being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14); and with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards you and your house are thoughts of peace, to give you a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a vessel of mercy, so that ***Christ*** might make known to you and your house the riches of His glory, we ask our Father in heaven in the mighty name of our Lord ***Jesus Christ*** (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14); petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38). What we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9). For it is written, "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12), and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) In ***Jesus'*** name (John 16:23) so be it. Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, for wisdom and might are His. And He changes the times and the seasons; He removes kings and raises up kings; He gives wisdom to the wise and knowledge to those who have understanding. He reveals deep and secret things; He knows what is in the darkness, and light dwells with Him. (Dan. 2:20-22) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
