MASS READING REFLECTION

Apr. 11, 2021 First Reading Acts 4:32-35 [True Christian Fellowship]

This passage depicts the early Church of Jerusalem. The emphasis is on being of "one heart and mind." Responsibility for one another was so deeply felt that they shared everything in common. It is a beautiful ideal that is still practiced in the Church's religious societies. It is a way of life that cannot be imposed on all. It must be freely chosen with the firm belief that "my strength and my courage is the Lord, and he has been my savior" (Responsorial Psalm).

> Second Reading Jn 5:1-6 [The Power of Faith]

"The victory that conquers the world is our faith." In reading about the Enthusiasm of the early Church (First Reading) and recalling the sophisticated way of life and moral decay in the Roman Empire that Christianity gradually overcame, one finds the clue for this accomplishment in John's statement. It is faith.

In our day, we see the power of sophistication and moral decay all around us. Seemingly, the Church is losing ground. Why? What about your faith? Is it still a power? Is it still very much alive?

"Birds of a feather flock together." With respect to certain instincts, we humans are no different from cows in a pasture flocking together when a thunderstorm is threatening. We need one another's company and inspiration to keep going. Marital love can survive only if the partners daily foster togetherness with all the means nature and religion suggest. The survival of faith is subject to the same conditions. A Christianity lived "alone," all by oneself, does not last. The First Reading describes the communal life of the early congregation in Jerusalem. "Koinonia" (fellowship, brotherhood, communion) should be an important element in the life of Christians of all ages. Faith, like love, is constantly exposed to the temptation of doubt and indifference. We need one another's support. You are blessed, if you have/ belong to a family where Christian fellowship is part of family life; where the members pray/worship together, read the Bible together, practice the Christian values of love, justice, mutual respect, decency, and concern together. In such a case, the members of the family carry one another and that fellowship keeps faith alive.

Fellowship should also be part of every congregation though this poses a problem in a large parish. We need belonging! Parish Councils should discuss available options. Participate in some activity of your parish. Do not be a loner! Without being exclusive, have friends who feel the same as you do in matters of faith. And at meetings, contribute to the value of "belonging" for all. Listen, be open to others, exchange ideas and experiences, share time and talents. "[The brethren] devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life" (Acts 2:42). The above may suggest how to realize this in our time and culture.
