Principal's Report Mr. Bartels

* Incentive dances are coming up, it will be held in the gym with Mr. Medeiros DJing. 6th grade will be on May 17th and 7th/8th grade will be on May 16th. Students must have 4 or less missing assignments, 2 or less referrals to the office, and no suspensions during the 4th quarter to attend the event.

* We are almost fully staffed for 2019-2020. A couple positions are open, but have not been posted yet to fill.

* Thank you to the exiting PTO board for their time and all they have done for our students and staff.

Boundary Meeting Update/Information Lisa Carlson

* OPS is working towards having no shared zones, currently there are 2.

* Zones are being drawn based on a goal of having each high school at 75% - 77% capacity with home attendance area students, allowing for the rest to be filled by students opting in.

- * At the boundary meeting each table was presented with 3 options and asked to weigh the pros and cons of each option.

Wing Ceremony Update Lisa Carlson/Christi Koch

- * The committee requested an additional \$160 to be added to the wing ceremony budget this year to provide a reusable banner and Instagram frames that can be used at future wing ceremonies.
- * We will be asking 8th grade families and students to make donations towards a bench to be installed near the front doors as a gift from the graduating class of 2023.
- * The Davis Alumni Scholarship will be given out for the first time this year to a former Davis student who is graduating from Central and one who is graduating from Burke. They will each receive \$350 and will make a speech at the wing ceremony this year.

Spanish Information and OEA presentation/update Cathy Scurlock

- * Monday was the first day of the Avant Stamp testing, students are doing great so far! High Scores will be acknowledged for 8th graders at the wing ceremony and for 7th graders at their AWD ceremony.
- * There will another parent meeting for anyone interested in going on the 8th Grade trip to Puerto Rico next year on May 9th at 6pm in Mrs. Scurlock's classroom. Students must be enrolled in Spanish next year and must be in 8th grade next year to be eligible for the trip.
