2019 KCRW SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

\$1,000

(***Note:** KCRW will award TWO \$1,000 scholarships to the top two finalists)

Eligibility requirements:

- Attend a public, private, or home school and live within the BISD/CISD Boundaries or in Kendall County for no fewer than two academic years at the time of the award.
- Be in his/her senior year of high school.
- Have applied to and subsequently been accepted to an accredited college, university or technical/vocational school at the time of funding of the scholarship.
- Exhibit academic excellence by having maintained an accumulated GPA of 85 (3.0) or higher for his/her junior and senior years of high school.
- Exhibit leadership qualities by having engaged in no less than two extracurricular activities during his/her high school career, or served as an officer in one organization.
- Participate in community service, volunteer work, or obvious contribution to the family household or business.
- Provide a completed Scholarship Application with all required attachments **postmarked by May 31, 2019 to KCRW, PO Box 122, Boerne, TX 78006 or scanned and uploaded to: kcrwtx@gmail.com by midnight on deadline.**
- (It is highly recommended that applications be returned via email as KCRW cannot review applications that do not arrive within 5 days after postmark deadline.)
- Finalists will be notified by email/phone call and may be asked to participate in a phone interview. The committee will meet, review, and name winners by **June 15.**
- The two winning essays may be published in an upcoming newspaper column in local media, and be uploaded to the KCRW website.

The KCRW does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, nationality, or ethnic origin in the administration of any of its policies or procedures.

Instructions for submitting an application:

- The application must be fully completed; incomplete applications will not be considered.
- The application deadline is **May 31, 2019**.
 - a. A photocopy of SAT and/or ACT test scores and official school transcript must accompany the application.
- Two **non-family member** letters of reference must accompany the application.
- Parent signatures are mandatory.
- Applications may be returned to **KCRW, PO Box 122, Boerne, TX 78006 and must be postmarked by May 31 or they may be scanned/uploaded by midnight on May 31 to: kcrwtx@gmail.com**
- The scholarship committee will be made up of a panel of KCRW members and their appointees who will be assign essays a point system that will be combined with GPA, recommendations, community service and other qualifications on the application page.**
- Immediate family members of the KCRW scholarship panel will **not** be eligible. Family members of KCRW members-at-large or who are members of other area GOP organizations and who do ***not*** participate in the judging will be eligible. KCRW membership is **not** mandatory and will not affect the final judging.

Obligations and Duties

- Each contestant must realize that he/she must remain in compliance with the rules stated herein and the rules of the school that he/she attends, at all times.
- The scholarship award winner(s) agree to appear at functions that the KCRW Scholarship Committee deems necessary, if at all possible, and/or agree to have their photo published when receiving award.
- All applicants must be good citizens at school and in the community. They must not have any disciplinary actions on their high school record or on their public record.
- Award winners must meet all graduation requirements in order to be eligible to receive the scholarship award.
- Award winners must submit a copy of a letter of admission and proof of college registration to an accredited school or college of higher learning to KCRW Scholarship Committee in order to be eligible to receive payment of the scholarship award.
- Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the School, College or University in the recipient's name. It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure that tuition is paid in full by the deadline set forth by the School, College or University.

Timeline:

- Applications are due no later than **May 31, 2019**.
- Recipients will be publicly announced in local media and/or at high school scholarship award ceremonies and other venues as deemed appropriate by KCRW.

Required Attachments

***** Please note that the following information is required. Attachments 1-3 may be included on the same typed sheet. Attachment 4 should be on a separate typed sheet. If the information is not included in the application documents your application will not be considered.**

1. **Extracurricular Activities** (Please attach an additional typed sheet):
List your high school accomplishments of which you are most proud include dates of involvement as well as leadership roles and dates held.
2. **Community Involvement** (Please attach an additional typed sheet):
List a minimum of **three** voluntary community involvement activities in which you have participated outside of school.
3. **Work Experience** (Please attach an additional typed sheet):
List employment during high school and summer breaks; include start and end dates, employer/supervisor name and phone number, and job duties/hours worked.
4. **Essay** (Please attach an additional typed sheet):
The essay should be typewritten in **12-point font, double-spaced**, and not more than 750 words. Follow academic standards for margins (1" top, bottom and sides) and place your name, planned major field of study, and date in the upper left hand corner.

Write an **essay** based on the following topic:

“How can the Republican party better engage and appeal to young conservatives?”
