



Membership Model

Based on the fact that Kingdom Believers is a Christ-centered, disciple-driven ministry, the diagram below depicts Christ and the work on the cross remains as a constant center of all we do at Kingdom Believers. As a ministry, we are commanded to disciple. Matthew 28:19 states Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:

- 1 The process begins with “you” the member nourishing your personal life with the elements of Christ-like character. This means doing whatever it takes personally to manage your spiritual life. This would include, but not limited to, maintaining personal Bible study, prayer and family devotion. In addition, the believer is to exemplify such character in every area of his/her life. Matthew 5:16 says *Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.*
- 2 As you are consistent and progressive in your personal worship devotion, connection with the body of baptized believers is essential. Hebrews 10:24-25 NIV says *And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, 25 not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.* The relationship between the member and Kingdom Believers is reciprocal. Kingdom Believers is responsible for providing members with Christian education, worship, praise and a conduit in which to cultivate spiritual and natural gifts and talents. Members utilize their gifts and talents for the furtherance of the ministry.
- 3 As the member continues to maintain his spiritual divine life, he becomes an influence to those he comes in contact with. The member receives discipleship education and is commissioned to engage, build rapport and invite others to Christ.
