II. Mechanics

- A. The number of recipients will be selected annually.
- B. The recipient(s) of the scholarship will be contacted individually via email and recognized on the Skylarship Foundation website.

- D. Payment will be made upon proof of college/trade school registration. The award must be used within two years of high school graduation.
- E. Students will complete the application as provided. This application is in FOUR parts. Begin by filling in the information requested; then proceed to parts two, three and four.
- F. The student must submit recommendation letters from two individuals; including one current or former teacher. Relatives cannot write recommendation letters for the student.
- G. The student must submit the essay as outlined on the attached page.
