Journal Entries

Each week you will be required to write a short journal entry about the verse for that week. Below are some ideas of what to write about. You can choose write about any or all of these ideas:

- Explain what you think the verse means in your own words.
- How does this verse apply to you and your life?
- These verses are all about love. Share a story about how you showed love toward someone this week, or share a situation where you did not show love but should have.
- Share how God is working in your life right now. What else is he teaching you? What do you want to improve on as a Christian?

Answer these questions if you have trouble thinking of things to write:

- Jan. 26: What does a "resounding gong" or "clanging cymbal" sound like? What does that have to do with a lack of love?
- Feb. 2: What is the gift of prophecy? What is the most important: knowledge, faith, or love? Why?
- Feb. 9: Is giving to the poor a bad thing? What is more important? Why?
- Feb. 16: When was a time you did not show patience or kindness? When was a time you were envious, boastful, and/or proud? How did you feel afterward? How should we act if we have love?
- Feb. 23: What does it mean to dishonor others? What is self-seeking? Have you ever done those things? If you have love, how should you act?
- Mar. 2: Have you ever delighted in evil? Has something bad ever happened to someone else and you were kind of happy about it? Is that love?
- Mar. 9: What does it mean to persevere? What is an example of love persevering?
- Mar. 16: How are you doing with showing love to others? What parts of love do you need to work on the most? How will you do that?
