THIS DATE IN HISTORY

Nov 4, 1953 Dwight Eisenhower is elected president.

Nov 8, 1961 John F. Kennedy defeats Richard M. Nixon for president.

Nov 16, 1961 In accordance with President Kennedy's decision to increase military aid to South Vietnam without committing U.S. combat troops, U.S. Air Force cargo planes began shuttling in more U.S. instructors and advisers.

Nov 22, 1963 President Kennedy is assassinated in Dallas, TX; Vice President Lyndon Johnson assumes the presidency.

Nov 2, 1964 The Soviet Union delivers a major shipment of arms in Cambodia, to replace U.S. equipment no longer available.

Nov 10-20, 1965 The U.S. 1st Cavalry Division and ARVN troops launch Operation Silver Bayonet in Pleiku Province, II Corps, a follow up operation to the clash at the Plei Me Special Forces camp. The purpose of the operation is to seek out and destroy Communist forces operating in the Ia Drang Valley.

Nov 11, 67-Nov 11, 68 The Americal Division conducts Operation Wheeler/Wallowa, search and destroy operations to clear the enemy out of Quang Nam and Quang Tin Provinces, I Corps

Nov 1, 1968 U.S. Air Force launches Operation Commando Hunt, a joint service effort to interdict enemy supply lines along the 1,700 mile length of the Ho Chi Minh Trail.


Nov 30, 1969 The U.S. 3rd Marine Division officially departs South Vietnam...


