

Privacy Policy

What information do we collect?

Protecting your privacy is very important to us. We're telling you about sesinsureme.com's privacy policy so you know what information we collect, why we collect it, and what we do with it. We do not collect information from you when you visit on our site.

Sesinsureme.com doesn't collect any personally identifiable information (PII) about you during your visit to our website unless you choose to provide it to us. What do we use your information for?

How do we protect your information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information.

We offer the use of a secure server. All supplied sensitive information is transmitted via Secure Socket Layer (SSL) technology and encrypted in our Database to be only accessed by those authorized with special access rights

to our systems. All authorized persons are required to keep the information confidential.

You do not have to give us personal information to visit sesinsureme.com. However, if you choose to receive alerts or e-newsletters, we collect your email address to complete the subscription process. If you choose to provide us with personally identifiable information through an email message, request for information, paper or electronic form, questionnaire, survey, etc., we will maintain the information you provide only as long as needed to respond to your question or to fulfill the stated purpose of the communication.

In order to contact you we store your personal information in a secure record system. We will safeguard the information you provide in accordance with the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended (5 U.S.C.
