- who** Sponsored by the Trail End State Historic Site & the Trail End Guilds (Organizers) in support of small groups and solo acts (Performers), be they Acoustic or Electronic, Classical or Jazz, Blues or Country, Latin or Irish, Rock or Alternative, Vocal or Instrumental ... even Comedy or Improv
- what** Intimate evenings of entertainment at the Carriage House Theater, 419 Delphi Avenue (Venue)
- why** Making money and maximizing Venue use for the Organizers while providing income and exposure for the Performers
- where** Carriage House Theater, 419 Delphi Avenue, Sheridan WY
- when** Performances at 7:30 p.m.; dates to be agreed upon by Organizers and Performers
- how** See below (additional details available at time of scheduling)

CAPACITY Because the Venue only seats 88 people, the Small Stage Concert Series is perfect for Performers who aren't necessarily appropriate for bars and/or the area's larger concert halls. For many, the income from a single sold out concert will be more than they usually make in a year's worth of public outings.

TICKETS Admission will be \$15 per person, with proceeds divided on a percentage basis. The more tickets sold, the more everyone makes. Disbursement of proceeds will occur within thirty (30) days of the Performance, and will be as follows:

- Performers (40% of gross/\$6.00 of each ticket sold)
- Organizers (40%/\$6.00)
- State of Wyoming (13%/\$2.00 – mandatory fee)
- Civic Theater Guild (7%/\$1.00 – for the use of the hall)

PUBLICITY Organizers will be in charge of publicity through posters, press releases and social media (other advertising is cost prohibitive). In hopes of maximizing exposure, thus increasing ticket sales, all Performers will be encouraged to share details with as many people as possible through whatever means they choose.

VENUE PREP Organizers will be responsible for activating/deactivating/operating Venue security systems, air conditioning and/or heating plant, and all lights (stage, house and courtyard). Organizers will also provide personnel to handle refreshments, ticket sales, clean up before and after the concerts, etc.

PERFORMANCES Performers will be responsible for their own instruments, microphones, sound systems, chairs, music stands, extension cords, etc., as well as sales of CDs or other performance-related items.

BE ADVISED Smoking is not allowed in the Venue. Alcohol use is strictly prohibited. The Venue's second floor and box office will be off limits before, during and after performances.
