Then those who, in many cases, despite having issues at their own homes, came in on Thursday morning to still no internet service, meaning no phones, etc. including Diane, Maria, Micaella, Marie and Debbie, are also much appreciated.

Please be reminded that we all need to have at least 2 working flash lights, with back up batteries for them, in case of an outage in the future. Even if sometime in the future, we are able to purchase a generator, it will likely only keep our kitchen refrigeration and an elevator working during the outage. Additional lighting will still be needed. Another reminder; do not use real candles during a power outage (of course, battery operated candles are fine and a good idea).
