The Springfield Swim Club's 65th season is quickly approaching. The Board of Governors has begun preparing the pool for the enjoyment of our membership.

NOTICE OF DUES INCREASE

This year, member families will see a minimal increase in our dues structure – our first dues increase since the 2014 season. A Family Dues increase of \$25.00 per family is being implemented to help offset increases to recurring operating expenses. The maintenance fee remains the same at \$100 with a \$65.00 rebate available for each member family (details below).

IMPROVEMENTS THIS YEAR

Since Labor Day the Board has been busy preparing the pool for the 2019 season and we're excited about three big improvements this year. We are installing a new, state of the art playground system in one of our green areas, kicking off a multiyear chair replacement program, and restoring the basketball court as part of a new basketball program we plan to implement this season.

SPRING WORK WEEKENDS

As winter ends and spring begins, we will be preparing the pool and grounds for another summer season. All adult members are encouraged to come out and help prepare the pool for the new season. **\$65.00 of your maintenance fee will be refunded** after you perform four (4) consecutive hours of work. Additional work sessions are compensated with a Family Guest Pass good for up to 5 guests.

Work sessions will begin on April 6th and will be held each Saturday up through May 18th. Work sessions are for **adult members only** (no children under the age of 18 are permitted). Work hours 9 am to 1 pm or 10 am to 2 pm.

LIFEGUARDS WANTED

We will be offering American Red Cross training classes again this year for Lifeguard Certification (May 17, 2019 through May 19, 2019) and recertification (May 18, 2019). HOURS OF OPERATION

EARLY-SEASON: Saturday, May 25th through the last day of school for the Springfield School District:

Monday – Thursday: 4:00pm - 7:00pm; **Friday:** 4:00pm - 9:00pm

Saturday: 10:30am - 9:00pm; **Sundays:** 11:30pm - 7:00pm;

Memorial Day Hours: 10:30am - 7:00pm

REGULAR SEASON: First full day of summer for the Springfield School District through Sunday, September 1st:

Monday – Saturday: 10:30am - 9:00pm; **Sundays:** 11:30pm - 9:00pm

Labor Day Hours (Final Day – Monday, September 2nd): 10:30pm - 7:00pm

Based on the 2019 Springfield School District calendar, our first regular season day is Saturday, June 15th. As the season approaches and the school calendar converges, we will notify the membership of any required changes to our transition to Regular Season Hours. PAYMENT AND DUES INFORMATION

There will be a \$25.00 increase to Family Dues beginning with the 2019 season. 1. Dues must be paid for every child born before May 1, 2017.
2. Caretaker Pass information and applications can be obtained by contacting the Membership Committee or the Swim Club Business Manager.
3. Only family members who are full-time residents of Springfield qualify as members. For questions or assistance contact the Membership Committee or the Swim Club Business Manager.
4. Dues are based on family information provided for the previous year. Additions or other corrections to family information listed on your invoice should be sent to the Swim Club Business Manager (Joe Sillo) by email or phone at 610-690-1706.
5. Dues paid before April 15th are eligible for an early payment discount of \$25.00. Dues paid after May 1st will be subject to a late charge of \$10 per week. Payment of dues will never be accepted at the pool.
6. Shareholders wishing to terminate their membership must do so before April 15th or be subject to forfeiture of ½ of the minimum dues rate, deducted from the actual share value. Shareholders withdrawing after May 15th will be subject to forfeiture of the minimum dues rate plus surcharges, deducted from the actual share value.

You must contact a Membership Committee Member prior to April 15th to avoid Termination Penalties

7. Shareholders not completing the withdraw process prior to April 15 will be subject to pay ½ the minimum dues rate. Shareholders completing the withdraw process after May 15 will be subject to the minimum dues and surcharges. These penalties will be deducted from the share value before refunding. IMPORTANT POOL POLICIES AND INFORMATION

- **All members regardless of age** are required to have a photo ID card. Proof of residency is required.
- All dues and fees must be paid before admittance to the pool will be granted.
- **All members regardless of age** must present their cards each time they enter the pool. A teen or adult member must accompany a child under the age of 12 while at the pool.
- **New members** (anyone joining after Memorial Day of the previous year) must attend an orientation session at 7:00 pm on either Tuesday, May 21ST or Wednesday May 22ND at the pool. Membership cards will not be issued until doing so. New families unable to attend must arrange an orientation appointment with the Membership Committee.
