- This is a family event. No flammable or harmful items may be displayed.
- No booth sharing is allowed.
- The NBC event is not responsible for any loss or theft incurred by any vendor.
- Vendors are responsible for removing all trash from their after the event and may not use the Nogales High School trash receptacles for its disposal.
- Vendor must notify the NBC immediately of cancellation.
- Food Vendors must have a Santa Cruz County food handlers permit.
- Food carts must have the Santa Cruz Health Department license.
