

## EXPANDED EYE CARE PROGRAM A GLORIOUS SUCCESS

The Board and staff of Infant Jesus Community Hospital (IJCH) have been extending health care to more and more people of Ishiagu, Nigeria each month. When they realized there was a great need for more specialized eye care, and came to us with a comprehensive plan to accomplish this, Uplift Health International, Inc. gladly agreed to fund this much-needed program. The Franciscan Sisters of the Immaculate Conception, who run the Hospital, contracted with the Daughters of Charity Rehab Centre Ossiomo-Ogan Eye Hospital, to provide eye evaluations and treatment at IJCH. First, the staff of IJCH, through their amazing outreach, gathered hundreds of villagers who needed to be seen. Three eye specialists spent the next 2 days screening and treating these patients. Some needed glasses, some medicine and some needed surgery that is being provided by the Eye Hospital surgeons at IJCH. It was a beautiful experience for all involved, working together to bring this essential health program to so many. In total, 1,017 people were screened and treated. Of the 171 identified for surgery, 25 were completed and the work continues with 3 surgeons following up the other cases. This program is now part of the Hospital's ministry and will continue. The people of Ishiagu are so delighted and relieved and we at UHI, Inc. thank each and every one of our donors for making this all a reality. We hope, as you read about this wonderful program, you felt our thanks and gratitude for your support!
