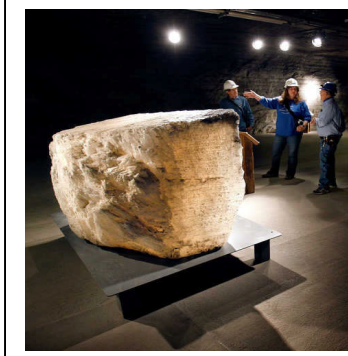

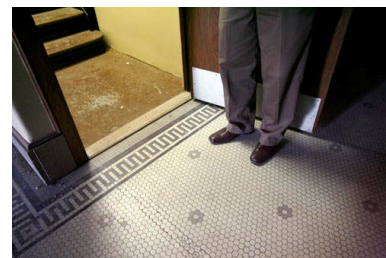
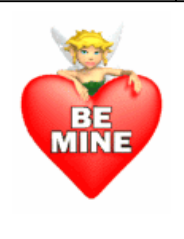

**RAZING THE ROOFS WITH A PURPOSE**

Three homes in 200 Block of West 5<sup>th</sup> that had been in various stages of disrepair and dilatation were recently tore down to make way for new housing units. (this is across street from Dillon's)

Two of the houses are on parcels the city of Hutchinson recently bought to clear the way for a new housing project, the Townhomes of Santa Fe Place, a pocket neighborhood of 10 workforce housing units to be built as duplexes and townhomes by New Beginnings, a nonprofit housing agency. Using grants and conventional financing, New Beginnings has the money it needs to build the first duplex. Under terms of a Neighborhood Stabilization Program grant, that first duplex must be completed by Sept. 20. Other units will be built as New Beginnings arranges additional financing. The housing is targeted for young professionals and families with income ranging from 80 to 120 percent of area median income, or \$41,850 to \$62,780. Rent is expected to be \$750 to \$800 a month.

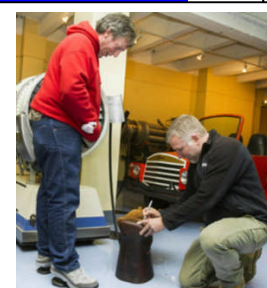
