

**AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO**  
**ORDINANCE: O-2014-34A**

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COUNCIL OF AMELIA VILLAGE, OHIO MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES & OTHER EXPENDITURES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2014 FOR AMELIA VILLAGE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village is required by statute to prepare and adopt annual permanent appropriations of Village revenues for current expenses and other expenditures for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2014;

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2014, the Village Council adopted Ordinance Number O-2014-14 authorizing the permanent appropriations for current expenses and other expenditures during fiscal year 2014; and

**WHEREAS**, supplemental appropriations are necessary at this time, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of Amelia Village during said fiscal year.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio as follows:

**SECTION I.** It is necessary to provide for additional expenditures of Amelia Village during the year ending December 31, 2014, the following amounts be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

**SECTION II.** That there be appropriated from the Amelia General & Main St/Woodlands Dr. Improvement Funds:

**SECTION III.** Village Council finds these supplemental appropriations are necessary to provide sufficient funds for the several obligations of the Village.

**SECTION IV.** Village Fiscal Officer is hereby directed to make the supplemental appropriations as outlined in this Ordinance.

**SECTION V.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.

**SECTION VI.** Amelia Village Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and, that all deliberations of the Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in the formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in foil compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

MRS. GERBER seconded the motion;


