- \$18,000 estimated budget for 2016-2017. Will be a little less because there are a number of students who have dropped out.
- \$14,000 in equipment budget. The Timpani repair will take about \$1000, \$2000 is going to Brittany
- Picture for the program – deadline is August 15 and band will not have all arrived by then. Will beg for an extension. We are going to try to get the kids all fitted before then and do a photo by the afternoon of the 16th. Senior pictures will also be taken then. We will try to email a digital copy to parents who request. Will get to Suzanne on the 17th.
- September 1 – first home game we will try to have as many as possible. No half time show, but in t-shirt “pep band” performance from the stands.
