### Games - HALVE IT

I was out and about the other night and I ran into a new kind of soft tip machine. (who cares right?) Anyway, this thing had many games on it, and one reminded me of one we used to play. It's called Halve It. This is one of many variations of the game that combines cricket numbers with doubles & triples.

The object is to finish with the most points. Each player starts with 40 points. You then get three darts (one throw) at each of the following: 20, 19, any double, 18, 17, any triple, 16, 15, bull (single or double). For example, you shoot at 20's and hit a single and a triple; you score 80 plus your 40 you started with for a total of 120 points. Your opponent hits triple 5, 5, double 1 (no 20's), so they did not hit the desired target, so the 40 points they started with his halved to 20. The game continues until you have shot at all of the above listed numbers. (when halving an odd number, round up; half of 99 becomes 50)

After you've played this & feel it's easy, why not try the English version; often called Murder. Replace those numbers with: 20, 16, double 7, 14, triple 10, double bull.

# All\*Star Qualifiers to begin August 15th

- Open Preliminary Qualifiers will be held at various DDA sponsored locations beginning August 15th, and ending September 22, 1995.
- The final Preliminary Qualifier will be held September 23, 1995.
- Women's Match Play eliminations will be held September 30 and October 8, 1995.
- Men's Match play eliminations will be held October 1 and October 7, 1995.
- Exact locations and times will be announced soon. Flyers will be posted in all DDA sponsored locations the second week of August.

### Format

The All\*Star Tournament will be held November 19, 1995 in Columbus, Ohio.

The Gem City All\*Star Team will consist of 26 men and 14 women.

The first 10 men and 6 women will be determined by Preliminary Qualifiers. The Preliminary Qualifying scores will be the <u>total of an individual's three (3) highest scores</u>.

The remaining team will be determined by 4 Match Play eliminations (2 for the men; 2 for the women), to be held at designated DDA sponsored locations.

Fees: \$1.00 per attempt (1 game) for all Open and Scheduled Preliminary Qualifiers. There is a one-time \$2.00 fee for Match Play.

This fall you will see some changes in the league. The Board of Directors has discussed and voted in the following:

-there will be a single team game instead of a best of 3 match. This is intended to keep things the same (still having a team game) and to speed up the match for those that seem to spend alot of time on the old team game (only one game). This game will count for one point, so the total points per match will decrease by two for all divisions. The game has been altered in some divisions: 1001 for A bracket; 801 for B bracket & 601 for C bracket.

-the team scores will not be set to zero after seven weeks. This will eliminate the often confusing playoff situation. Instead, a position round will occur on week 15 where the first place team plays the second place team and 3rd plays 4th & so on.

-the membership fee has been changed from \$10 (with an optional ADO \$1) to \$11 (since the ADO changed its requirements).

These and other changes are constantly being considered by the Board of Directors for improving our fine league. Our monthly board meeting is open to all interested parties. It is held on the third Tuesday of each month at the Greenmont center. Call 291-DART for more information.
