

FAQ: What can you do to protect your pets?

Follow these steps.

- See if your water contains chlorine. You can find this information in the ***Consumer Confidence Report*** tab for the water system.
- If your water contains chlorine: Chlorine evaporates quickly, so the easiest method of removing it from water is to put it in an open container and let it sit still for a couple of days. Alternately, chlorine may be eliminated from water by boiling it or adding salts.

Products for removing chlorine, as well as kits to test your water are available at many pet and aquarium supply stores. These stores may also be a good resource for information on care for your pets.
