Entering 1st & 2nd Grade

Math

All students entering 1st and 2nd Grade are expected to know their basic math facts upon entering the school year in August 2021. Please practice these skills together as a family. Those entering 1st Grade should know their addition and subtraction facts from (0-10), and those entering second Grade should know their addition and subtraction facts (0-20). Flashcards are a great way to practice these facts!

Reading

All students entering 1st and 2nd Grade should read for approximately 20-30 minutes a day. The following are recommended books for each grade level. Another good resource to use for online books is **getepic.com**. A parent account can be created, and students can choose from many different genres of books.
