

C.A.R.A. Track and Field Meet Information

The following contains information regarding the meet held at Eaton High School on Saturday, June 16th.

Facility Information

- There is NO gate fee for this meet.
- Parking is available in the high school and middle school parking lots, as well as along 3rd and 1st streets.
- Please pay attention to the facility map for places where team camps/tents are allowed.
- Parents/spectators will need to watch events from outside of the fence around the track area.
- Other than athletes who are competing in the long jump (or those about to take the track for an event) the infield area is to remain clear.
- After completing a running event, athletes will exit at the gate a little beyond the finish line. If they are running in the next event, they will need to walk back to the staging area after they exit.
- Please see the facility map for the location of the bathrooms.
- Concessions will be sold at the concession stand.
- Please do not bring any animals into the facility.
- Do not go on the baseball field at any time.

Event Information

- All athletes must report to the staging area for any running event. Only coaches, athletes, and meet volunteers are allowed in this area.
- Field Events will begin at 8:30 and running events will begin at 9:00.
- We will follow the order of events for age groups in field events and running events (see next page for the CARA schedule).

Additional Reminders

- The coaches meeting will take place at the finish line tent at 8:00 AM. Please have a representative at this meeting.
- Each agency is to supply one person (coach, parent, etc) to help at the finish line. This volunteer meeting will begin at 8:30 at the finish line tent.
- Please bring all necessary equipment/personnel to run your designated field event. You will pick-up ribbons for your field event at the coaches meeting. Extra ribbons should be returned at the end of your field event.
- Be sure to ask for a final call before closing any field events.
