### Sixth Elul (Shabbat)

The sixth of Elul (August 14, 2021) is a date that notes the word Elul is an acronym for the phrase "Ani l'dodi v'dodi li," meaning "I am my beloved's and my beloved is mine." Elul is a kind of annual honeymoon between divine and human, Elul represents the love, of mature mates who have gone through good and bad together. -Song of Songs 2:16

It is not a time to cover up flaws, but a time to assort them in the proper context as part of life's journey. Elul encourages us to view ourselves as loved enough to be vulnerable and honest in facing ourselves.

In Elul, the last month of the Hebrew year, we tell others we have offended, that we are sorry. This is a good way to improve our characters and spread the love of Elul. Always remember when we apologize we let others know that we find them worthy of dignity. By giving them the chance to forgive, we offer them the possibility of giving and receiving love.—*Psalms Rabbah 23:1*


