- 3- Discussion was made on continuing to monitor the Post Office for homeless possibly sleeping in lobby to get out of the cold.
- 4- Addressed male caught on camera stealing lights and drop cords from Town Hall; Kia soul with female in vehicle at the Blessing Box outside of Town Hall. Will continue to monitor box by checking computer recordings.
- 5- Waco T-Shirts addressed and availability along with cost of shirts being \$15.00 Each.
- 6- Addressed Waco Litter Sweep, and next sweep scheduled for 03/2024
